INCOMMON FEDERATION

The InCommon Federation is the U.S. education and research identity federation, providing a common framework for trusted shared management of access to online resources. Through InCommon, Identity Providers can give their users single signon convenience and privacy protection, while online Service Providers control access to their protected resources.

Catapult AMS is the only Athlete Management System member of InCommon.

InCommon supports Web-based distributed authentication and authorization services. Members of InCommon, including Universities and Colleges, enjoy the benefits and additional controls utilising a single authentication framework that covers Catapult AMS.

This means an organisation can make their own access decisions and user privacy controls are

decided on a case by case basis for each resource, providing higher security and more granular control.
